Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counting Cards Number on cover, draw that many objects inside. • Shape Cards Geometric shape on cover, draw object that has that shape inside. • Number Awareness Poster Collage that shows address numbers, phone numbers, digital clock, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pattern Show and Tell Show scenes that contain patterns (fence posts, window panes); tell about pattern. • Shape Show and Tell Show scenes and objects that have geometric shapes; tell what shape. • Number Awareness Show and Tell Show item that uses numbers (telephone, speedometer); tell how it uses them.
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Natural Process Cards Puppy on cover, dog inside; seed on cover, flower inside; etc. • Season Poster Four-part design showing signs-of-the-season scenes. • Nutrition Poster Table setting showing favorites from each food group on plate. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Habitat Show and Tell Show animals from a specific habitat (desert, marsh); tell about animals. • Our Bodies Show and Tell Show close-ups of body parts (nose, ear); tell what each body part does. • Animal Family Show and Tell Show members of an animal family (insects, mammals); tell their names.
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Community Helper Thank You Cards Firefighter, police officer, etc., on cover, thank you message inside. • Family Tree Poster Drawings and photographs to show three generations. • Cultural Awareness Poster Hispanic Heritage Month, Black History Month, Women's History Month, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • American Heroes Show and Tell Show famous Americans; tell who they are and what they achieved. • Transportation Show and Tell Show modes of travel (boat, balloon, skis); tell what they are. • World Explorer Show and Tell Show scenes from other countries; tell a fact about the country.
Art & Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Color Cards Color swatch on cover, draw objects that are that color inside. • Mood Cards Write emotion word on cover (surprised); picture to express that emotion inside. • Spatial Relations Poster Multi-part design with scenes to illustrate <i>on</i>, <i>under</i>, <i>inside</i>, <i>outside</i>, <i>beside</i>, etc. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sing-Along Show and Tell Show pictures to match song lyrics (Old MacDonald); sing along with slide show. • Color Show and Tell Show scene or object that has an assigned color; tell what it is. • Art Gallery Show and Tell Show a famous or favorite artwork; tell what it is and why you like it.
